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# CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE 主席寄語

This year marked the 20th anniversary of Hong Kong's return to the motherland, a significant moment in time underlined by President Xi Jinping's historic visit. President Xi affirmed the successful implementation of "One Country, Two Systems" and pledged that the Central Government would provide continued support for Hong Kong's development. He also charted out a vision for the future, advising Hong Kong to uphold the principles of "One Country" while capitalising on the advantages of "Two Systems".

Within three short months after the new-term Government took office, a new atmosphere is already emerging. We have been encouraged by the new-term Government's strengthened communication and cooperation with various sectors, urging Hong Kong to move forward in a united front. The Government has also taken prompt community actions by boosting new resources for quality education, setting up a land supply task force and visiting neighbouring regions with close ties to the city to improve Hong Kong's quality of life. It is gratifying to note that the Government has adopted a broad, forward-thinking approach with positive signs that the new cabinet is capable of accomplishing its goals.

Established in late 2014, Our Hong Kong Foundation has partnered with top-level experts to drive citywide progress in several major areas. We have conducted extensive public policy research and drafted proposals that benefit the long-term interests of Hong Kong. We have organised forums and serialised events to amplify mutual understanding between Hong Kong and the Mainland. We have also, in keeping with world trends, organised events and programmes that actively promoting innovation and technology development in Hong Kong. Beyond our fundamental role as a think tank, we strive to make the Foundation a Think and Do Tank.

Up to mid-2017, Our Hong Kong Foundation has published 10 reports that positively impact Hong Kong including research on land supply and housing, economic development and recommendations on social planning. Through organising serialised forums such as the "China Today Forum" and the "China Master Series", we have enjoyed privileged access to heavyweight speakers such as Mr. Mo Yan, Nobel Prize Laureate in literature, Professor Jin Yinan of PLA National Defence University, Mr. Yang Weimin, Deputy Director of Central Leading Group on Financial and Economic Affairs, and Mr. He Yafei, Former Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs. These great minds were able to share their insights on Chinese culture and the current state of affairs in China to provide greater understanding for the people of Hong Kong.

By organising the Mainland Expedition on Entrepreneurship and Technology, we facilitated the exchange of ideas between local and Mainland talents. With support from the Ministry of Science and Technology, we staged the InnoTech Expo for the second year running. Both events attracted elite participation from different sectors and greatly succeeded in attracting the public's attention.

今年是香港回歸祖國二十周年。國家主席習近平 對香港進行了具有重要歷史意義的訪問。 習主席充分肯定了"一國兩制"在香港的成功 落實,表示中央將一如既往地堅定支持香港的 發展,同時也指出了香港未來的發展方向,建議 香港要堅守"一國"之本,善用"兩制"之利。

新一屆特區政府在這個時候上任,一個新氣象,新景況,順勢而生。短短三個月,我們感受到和看到政府與社會各界,正在加強溝通合作,帶領香港放下歧見,攜手往前行。令人非常欣喜的是,新政府致力團結社會各界人士,溝通之餘亦迅速展開民生工作,推出優質教育新資源措施,成立土地供應專責小組;對外則拜訪多個與香港有密切關係的鄰近地區。我們樂見新政府展示廣闊的前瞻思維,亦從多方面顯示出,新班子是個有為政府。

團結香港基金成立於2014年年底,匯聚精英,從事三大領域工作,包括政策研究,為香港長遠整體利益出謀獻策;舉辦論壇與系列活動,推動內地與香港交流,促進兩地相互瞭解;以及順應環球創科大潮,全力倡議推動香港創科發展,配合連場活動,將基金會構成一個Think and Do Tank的嶄新智庫模式。

截至今年中,基金會發表10個關乎香港經濟民生的政策研究報告,包括土地房屋建設、經濟發展,以至各類社會規劃建議;基金會亦藉舉辦《今日中國》論壇等,包括「中華大講堂」等系列講座,邀請國家重量級名人親臨演講,例如諾貝爾文學獎得主莫言、中國人民解放軍國防大學金一南教授、中央財經領導小組辦公室副主任楊偉民、中國外交部前副部長何亞非等,分享中華文化及當代國情,令港人進一步瞭解國家現況。

基金會亦致力推動香港創科發展,除了發佈研究報告,說明發展創科有逼切性外,亦透過舉辦香港創業青年內地行等活動,促進兩地人才交流。此外,基金會更獲得國家科技部與多個部委支持,連續兩年舉辦「創科博覽」,活動

#### Rebuild the housing ladder by the Subsidised Homeownership Scheme

Hong Kong's public housing policy has long featured a housing ladder where public rental housing (PRH) tenants, when they have the ability, can first purchase subsidised flats through the Home Ownership Scheme (HOS), and finally private housing units. Nonetheless, currently a massive number of households are unable to achieve bona-fide homeownership, leaving the society to be divided into those haves and have-nots.

The key problem lies with the existing premium determination and repayment mechanism, where HOS owners are required to pay back the "unpaid land premium" to the Government before they can sell their units in the private market. This premium, however, is linked with the prevailing market prices and, with the significant rise in property prices, becomes unaffordable by the HOS owners. Therefore these HOS owners have no way to move onto the private market, rendering the housing leader to virtually become obsolete.

In this regard, we advocate the Government to implement our proposed Subsidised Homeownership Scheme (SHS), where all newly-constructed public housing units should focus on home ownership. Those who can afford can purchase the subsidised units, and for those who cannot afford to purchase, they should be allowed to rent-to-buy, rent first and buy later. With the Government acting as a guarantor, buyers of the SHS units can obtain a 90%-95% mortgage. Also, the Government has to rationalise the premium determination and repayment mechanism so that the amount of unpaid land premium would no longer be linked with the prevailing market prices.

#### 「補貼置業」重修「房屋階梯」

香港公營房屋政策原本設計了一條「房屋階梯」,讓市民從公屋到居屋、再到私人住宅,逐步達成目標。惟現行政策下,大量公營房屋住戶無法擁有單位的業權,令社會分成「有樓」與「無樓」兩大群組。

問題首先是「補價」機制。出售居屋前,須先繳付政府資助部分 — 即所謂的「補價」。此「補價」不以單位入住時的市價估值,而是按出售時的市價決定。隨着樓價暴升,「補價」成為天價,「房屋階梯」已名存實亡。

另外,按現時公屋編配標準,離婚父母,如有受供養孩子或選擇再婚時,再次申請公屋多獲優先,此安排隱含鼓勵離婚的誘因,促使家庭破碎,造成跨代貧窮。是次由團結香港基金倡導的「土地及房屋」研究,倡議政府推行「補貼置業計劃」,提議新建成的公共房屋以「置業」為目標,有能力置業者可購買「補貼出售」單位,否則可「先租後買」。政府一方面提供擔保,讓公屋戶獲得90%-95%按揭,減低首期負擔,另一方面,優化「補價」機制,不與浮動的市值掛鈎,公屋業主更易清付補價,晉身私人房屋市場。

# Increase land supply using a multipronged approach

The second part of the report is on "increasing land supply". We forecasted that in the next four years the annual average completion of new private housing will be approximately 18,000 units, representing a 60% increase comparing to the corresponding figure in 2006 to 2015. Yet, in terms of gross floor area (GFA), the increase is only 30%, which means that the average unit size will continue to shrink. Besides, we expected less than 100,000 public housing unit completions in the next five years, falling 30% short of the supply target. Moreover, we also saw a serious shortage in Grade A offices, commercial properties and industrial buildings.

The root cause is a lack of major land development projects in the last decade. We suggest that the Government should increase land supply and build a land reserve through a multipronged approach. These include rezoning; increasing development density; developing brownfields and country parks; and reclamation. We also urge the Government to remove the red tapes and speed up land development and approval process.

We have to join our hands in building a better living environment for our old and young generation. Together we can build our new "Rose Garden".



#### 多管齊下 增加土地供應

本報告第二部分是「增加土地供應」。香港人愈住愈細,愈住愈貴。 事實上,未來四年的年均私人住宅落成量約1.8萬個單位,雖較2006至2015年高出60%,但樓面面積增幅不足30%,預計未來單位只會日趨縮小。

公營房屋供應亦嚴重不足,預計五年間只有不足10萬個單位落成,與目標落差逾三成。此外,甲級寫字樓、商用物業及工廈亦供需失衡,情況更有所惡化,主要歸咎於香港過去十多年來欠缺大型土地發展項目。

考慮到土地短缺的嚴重性和迫切性,基金會建議政府多管齊下增加土地供應,包括改劃土地用途、增加發展密度、發展棕地、郊野公園及填海,建立土地儲備。另亦希望政府能拆牆鬆綁,以加快土地開發及審批程序。

今天,我們急需改善香港居住環境,為年輕人和老齡 人爭取更好生活,香港人必須團結,攜手建設另一個 「玫瑰園」。

#### From a city of tiny dwellings to an ideal home

Hong Kong is not renowned for its livability as tiny dwellings are the norm in the city. The city's per capita living space, at only 170 square feet, is even smaller than a car parking space. The severe shortage of land not only negatively impacts our quality of life but also affects Hong Kong's competitiveness vis-a-vis other fast-growing cities in the region.

We believe that increasing land supply is the best solution to tackle land shortages. Specifically, in response to the "Hong Kong 2030+" consultation paper, we suggested that the Government should implement large-scale reclamation projects, and facilitate the release of private land reserve so that more homes can be built through public-private partnerships.

At present, Hong Kong is facing a serious shortage in supply of both public and private housing. Not only does this cause a deterioration of living standards but also contribute to social conflicts. To make Hong Kong more livable, we should increase the per capita living space to 270 square feet (Singapore's level). This translates into more than 9,000 hectares of land, which is roughly equivalent to the size of 3 Shatin new towns, in the long run.

Additionally, restarting large-scale reclamations would help build a sustainable land reserve in the long run. For example, a large-scale artificial island can be built at Cheung Chau South, and reclamation can be carried out in areas like Lamma West. Tuen Mun and Tseung Kwan O. Furthermore, existing government facilities,



such as prisons, can be relocated to Po Toi Island. Also, we can take reference from Singapore's experience and carefully consider the position of the container ports to our society and economy, so as to devise a long-term development strategy.

In the short to medium-term, a mechanism can be set up to facilitate the development of private lands. We envisage that the Government would provide policy support and collaborate with private land owners to release the development potential of private land reserve. In return, these private land owners would be required to set aside a portion of the land for the development of subsidised housing.

Many Hong Kong's new towns were built on reclaimed land. Since 2000, however, there has been no new town being developed after Tung Chung. Restarting large-scale land development projects would promote economic growth, improve peoples' lives and provide better homes in the future.

#### 從蝸居城市到美好家園

香港蝸居情況一直為人詬病,目前人均居住面積只有 170平方呎,大小比不上一個車位,更尤甚者,面對 區內其他城市的高速發展,香港因土地嚴重短缺, 導致競爭力下滑。

要解決以上問題,必須增加土地供應,團結香港基金 就政府的《香港2030+》諮詢文件提出兩項建議: 一、推動大規模填海計劃;二、釋放私人土地儲備。 建議公私營合作模式,增加房屋供應。

目前,香港公營與私人房屋供應不足,令生活水平 下降,甚至觸發社會矛盾。決心改善香港成為宜居 城市,需大幅提高人均居住面積。長遠而言,若把香港 的人均居住面積提升至新加坡的水平(270平方呎), 再加上相關配套,估計需要逾9,000公頃土地,面積 等於3個沙田新市鎮。

為確保長遠能建立土地儲備,建議政府重啟大型填海 計劃,並提出多個填海選址及擴展方案,包括在長洲 南建設大型人工島;現有監獄及政府設施亦可搬遷 至蒲台島;以及在南丫島西、屯門、將軍澳區進行填海 擴建等。另外,參考新加坡經驗,香港值得認真研究 貨櫃碼頭對香港社會經濟的重要性,考慮其長遠發展 方向及選址。

至於中短期,政府可建立機制,試行與私人土地擁有者 合作,提供政策配套,促成私人土地擁有者在選定的發展 範圍內,興建住宅項目,而私人土地擁有者則須撥出某個 百分比的土地,給予政府發展資助出售房屋。

過去香港新市鎮發展都有賴大型填海工程,不過自 2000年以來,東涌新市鎮以後就無以為繼。香港要解決 經濟民生困局,必需重啟大型土地開發計劃,建設美好 家園, 迎來另一個黃金時代。



To strengthen Hong Kong's role in the international innovation and venture capital marketplace, and to encourage the increase in innovation expenditure by private enterprises, the Government can provide tax incentives so that in the long run,

China's box office revenue has seen impressive growth in recent years, and Hong Kong would become the ideal gateway for studios to gain access to the Mainland market. Moreover, the future looks rosy for educational, medical and legal services, and Hong Kong should increase public and private university places so to attract local and overseas talents.

Under the "One Belt One Road" initiative, Hong Kong can provide a wide variety of professional services, such as finance, accountancy, consultancy and arbitration, to 66 nations across Asia, Africa and Europe. Besides, Hong Kong should strive to lead Macao and 9 Guangdong cities in the development of a metropolitan zone in the Pearl River Delta area. Such an

idea also coincides with the Greater Bay Area concept, first floated at China's "Two Sessions" in March 2016.

# Five Opportunities for Hong Kong under "new normal"

After experiencing rapid expansion in the past 50 years, Hong Kong's economic growth is facing a downward pressure in recent years. At the same time, Mainland China's economy, which is closely linked to Hong Kong's prosperity, is also experiencing structural changes. As such, Hong Kong needs to adjust to the so-called "new normal" for growth.

To maintain economic vitality, the report identified five opportunities that Hong Kong can take advantage of. They are: becoming an international centre for finance; innovation and venture capital; and creative arts and professional services. Also, Hong Kong can become an economic cooperation centre for the "One Belt One Road" initiative and the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Bay Area (Greater Bay Area).

As a gateway city to the Mainland and an interaction point between China and ASEAN countries, the Government can consider issuing the relevant sovereign bonds. The revitalisation of Hong Kong's public bond market could lead to the issuance of Renminbi bonds in Hong Kong by Mainland companies, which would induce further development of Hong Kong's bond market.





#### 香港「新常態」下五大機遇

香港經歷過逾50年的高速增長,經濟近年出現下行壓力,而與香港發展密不可分的內地經濟,亦展開結構性轉型,進入所謂「新常態」, 香港需相對應地作出調整配合。

本報告指出,香港當前有五項機遇,包括發展成為國際金融中心、 創投中心、創意藝術中心、專業服務中心,以及面向「一帶一路」和 「大灣區」的經濟合作中心。

香港面向中國內地,同時又是中國與東盟地區的中轉站,政府可考慮發行政府相關的主權評級債券。活化公債市場將有助吸引內地機構來港發行人民幣債券,令香港債市進一步發展。

為加強香港在國際創投的角色,政府應提供科研税務寬減以鼓勵私人企業增加研發開支,長遠把香港的公、私營研發支出總和由現時佔本地生產總值的0.7%提升至4%。

中國內地的電影票房近年快速增長,香港將成為進軍國內最佳跳板。此外,教育、醫療及法律服務是三大極具潛力的專業服務,發展前景不俗。香港應增加公、私營大學學額,容納更多本地及海外人才。

在國家的「一帶一路」戰略規劃下,作為國際樞紐的香港可為橫跨歐、亞、非的66個國家提供服務,包括金融、會計、諮詢、法律仲裁等。香港亦應爭取成為珠三角經濟區的領頭羊,帶領廣東省9個城市:東莞、佛山、廣州、惠州、江門、深圳、肇慶、中山及珠海,再加上香港及澳門兩個特別行政區,發展成一個大都會。這個概念與今年3月「兩會」首次提出「粵港澳大灣區」不謀而合。

# RIDING ON MAINLAND'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN A NEW ERA 迎接時代變遷 與內地經濟並進



#### Forging a closer relationship with the Mainland

As China's economic prowess continues to grow, Hong Kong's importance in the Mainland economy will see a corresponding decrease. Therefore, it is important for Hong Kong to adjust and reposition itself as Mainland's close economic partner so that it can continue to play an indispensable role in China's next new wave of economic expansion.

Against this background, a series of policy recommendations was made in the report in terms of the flows of trade, capital, and people. In trade, Hong Kong needs to recognise the Mainland's demand for high value-added services. For example, opportunities exist in high-end tourism, for example, medical and beauty care tourism, cruise tourism, and MICE tourism. Apart from these, we can take advantage of the expansion of the movie industry in the Mainland, as Hong Kong has a wealth of professional experience in producing Chinese-language movies. Therefore, the Government should continue to support the development and investment of Hong Kong's movie industry to strengthen its competitiveness.

#### Key Recommendations:

- Review immigration policy to increase the number of young and highly educated immigrants to relieve the stress created by population aging and labour shortage.
- Develop high value-added services, which include high-end tourism, film and audiovisual services as well as financial
- Hong Kong can become a two-way gateway for China's capital flow by positioning itself as an offshore Renminbi

#### 主要建議:

- 政府應重新檢視輸入移民的政策,移民應是 受高教育程度的年輕人,以紓緩香港人口 老化、勞動力不足的問題。
- 發展高增值服務,包括發展高端旅遊、電影 及視聽服務及金融服務。

In terms of capital flow, Hong Kong can become a two-way gateway for China's capital flow by positioning itself as an offshore Renminbi "supermarket". In this "supermarket", Hong Kong can provide multiple Renminbi securities products to international investors. Also, Hong Kong can become a financial hub for the countries along the "One Belt One Road", and provide a dual U.S. Dollar and Renminbi financing

Hong Kong remains an attractive place for Mainland's professionals. As such, we need a more effective scheme to attract highly-skilled immigrants to increase Hong Kong's human capital and relieve the stress created by population aging and labour shortage. The Government has to review its immigration policy and implement a long-term population planning programme that incorporates the ancillary infrastructure support, so to increase the number of young and highly educated immigrants coming to Hong Kong through different channels. The Government can also adjust migrant quotas in stages so that the infrastructure can meet the needs of a rising population and lessen the impact of new immigrants on society.

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#### 與內地建更緊密關係

隨着中國的經濟實力不斷上升,香港對內地的重要性逐漸下降, 因此香港必須重新作出調整,定位為內地緊密的合作夥伴,爭取 在中國新一輪經濟增長中繼續成為不可或缺的角色。

本報告對本港與內地在物流、資金流及人才流三大範疇,提出 一系列政策建議。在物流方面,內地對高價值服務的需求日增, 香港應該把握當前機遇,提供高增值服務,其中包括發展高端 旅游,如醫療及美容旅游、郵輪旅游、會議及展覽旅游等。 另外,中國內地的電影市場不斷擴展。香港製作華語電影經驗 豐富,並具備專業知識,面對內地龐大電影市場機會,政府應持續 支持電影發展和投資,加強香港的電影產業競爭力。

資金流方面,香港可作為中國資金雙向流動的門戶, 定位香港的人民幣離岸市場為離岸「超市」,為國際 投資者提供多元化人民幣計價證券。香港更可成為 「一帶一路」 沿線國家的金融樞紐, 同時提供美元及人 民幣融資平台。

在人才流方面,香港對內地專業技術人才依然具吸引 力。我們應以更有效的方法輸入更多高技術移民,增加 香港人力資本,並紓緩人口老化、勞動力不足等問題。 政府應妥善地制訂長遠的人口規劃及基建配套,重新 檢視移民政策, 诱過更多途徑輸入年輕及高教育水平 的移民,亦可以分階段逐步調升移民名額,讓基建發展

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#### Key Recommendations:

# Reforming museums in Hong Kong to close the gap

Hong Kong is lagging behind the world in museum governance and recognition, and this is reflected in metrics like visitorship, membership, online presence and tourist ranking. As the Government is devoting considerable resources in local museums, the time is ripe for reform.

The report suggested that instead of running museums as governmental organisations, a publicly funded autonomous management model should be adopted for Hong Kong's public museums. In particular, an independent statutory board, tasked with setting up a diverse funding source, should be established to run the public museums. Also, employees of these museums should be separated from the civil service system.

Such a model would help public museums to integrate themselves into the community and attract corporate sponsorships and private donations, plus opening up other revenue sources. In addition, it would lead to an improvement in human resources management by cutting down the over reliance on the civil service, thus leading to a more open, diverse and flexible management system.

Research has indicated that the global trend for museum governance points to the autonomous model. In fact, M+, which aims to be the defining museum of 20th and 21st century visual arts in Asia, used to be a functional department of the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority. In 2016, it adopted the present-day independent governance model.

It is quite common that in overseas jurisdiction, a specially enacted legislation governs the running of museums. However, in Hong Kong, museums are operated under the colonial-era Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance, which also governs public sewers and drains, public slaughterhouses, cemeteries, libraries and civic centres. In light of the need to have a robust management system, we recommended the enactment of a museum law to provide for a clear legal regime, and an appropriate and professional governance model for public museums.

#### 改革香港博物館追落後

香港的博物館不論在訪客人數、會員數量、網絡知名度及旅遊景點 排名等都未能追上國際水平。同樣重要的是,本地博物館的法律地位 亦未如理想。但現在正值政府投入大量資源於博物館之時,這是重提 改革的良機。

本報告建議博物館管治改為政府資助、自主營運的管治模式,成立一個法定的博物館管理委員會,建立多元化經費來源,以及脫離現行的公務員體制。這個模式的好處有三點。第一,有助促進博物館融入廣大社群。第二,引入企業贊助及私人捐款,同時鼓勵博物館開拓其他收入來源。第三,放棄對公務員體制的過度依賴能改善現時博物館的人力資源管理,讓制度更開放、多元及富彈性。



經過對多個全球首屈一指、訪客量稱冠博物館的調查,都顯示博物館透過立法及重組轉向政府資助、自主經營的管治模式乃大勢所趨。立志成為亞洲 20 及 21 世紀視覺文化藝術標誌的香港西九文化區 M+,也在短短數年間內逐步邁向自主管治。M+原本是西九文化區管理局旗下的功能部門,後來於 2016 年 4 月14 日成立現時的獨立管理架構。

海外地區通常有專為博物館訂立的法例,不過,本港的博物館仍受制於殖民時代的《公眾衛生及市政條例》,內文亦只簡短提及到博物館的管治,並與下水道及排水渠、公營屠房、墳場、圖書館和文娛中心相提並論。本報告檢視世界各地的博物館條例作為香港可考慮的方案,建議政府因時制宜,制訂《博物館法》,以明確博物館的法律地位,制訂專業和合適的管理模式。



Additionally, we advocate the implementation of an aging policy through collaboration between the Government, the private sector and the civil society. The policy will guide us in the investment in


a healthier population, as well as the promotion of healthy living for the public. Also, an aging policy will help us to improve productivity and reduce medical and societal resources wastage

through more progressive social policies, systems and structures which can then lead to a

Through this scheme, health checkups and treatments on specified chronic illnesses will be subsidised. 

全球老齡化加劇,香港的65歲及以上的人口比例, 將於2034年升至30%。傳統而言,老齡人口不斷 增加,將會對經濟生產力造成負面影響。但如果 政府能及時推行適當的政策,老齡人口實際上可推動 新一輪經濟增長,稱為第二次人口紅利。

本報告提出的「盛齡城市」概念受到社會關注。 所謂「盛齡城市」是通過城市環境的改變,讓社會 每一個人,讓他們無論年齡大小,都能為社會做出 貢獻,擁有自己充實的人生。

要成就「盛齡城市」,香港社會需要投放資源改善 市民健康。據研究顯示,推行預防疾病及慢性疾病 管理計劃,及早為中年人士進行身體檢查和及早發 現患病者,會為社會帶來很多好處。本報告建議為 45歲及以上,這個患上慢性疾病風險較高的年齡群 提供「慢性疾病管理醫療券計劃」,資助他們進行 身體檢查及治療指定慢性疾病。同時,當局應成立

#### Producing rewards of the second demographic dividend

The world's population is aging fast, and Hong Kong is no exception. The percentage of the population aged 65 and above will increase to 30% by 2034. Traditionally, an aging population means a negative impact on economic growth. However, if proper policies are implemented, an aging population can propel a new wave of economic growth, where rewards of the second demographic dividend can be reaped.

The idea is that we need investments for the celebration of aging. Through changes in the urban environment, we would enable every person, irrespective of their age, to contribute to society and to have a fulfilled life.

To achieve this goal, resources have to be allocated in improving the health of our citizens. According to research, implementing a preventative care and chronic illness management plan, as well as providing health checkups for middle-aged persons will bring enormous

Hong Kong's population is aging rapidly, and there are concerns that the broader society is ill-prepared to deal with the needs of the growing number of seniors. While this suggests a crisis is looming on the horizon, things could be turned for the better if we leverage the power of gerontechnology, an interdisciplinary field that combines gerontology and technology.

This report was the first-ever landscape study on gerontechnology in Hong Kong. Through the four focus areas, living; health care; diet and transportation, it looked into 72 products and services with the potential of widespread use in Hong Kong. A robust gerontechnology ecosystem not only benefits seniors and their caregivers but also injects vitality to the innovation and technology sector for new product inventions. Ultimately, such a cycle would give an extra push to the economy's overall productivity. However, the sector is facing many difficulties, and it is not easy for gerontechnology to thrive in Hong Kong.

For example, gerontechnology products are excluded from the Elderly Health Care Voucher Scheme and the Pilot Scheme on Community Care Service Voucher for the Elderly. If there are subsidies for seniors to purchase gerontechnology products, this could help inject more capital into the sector.

In fact, for many startups the cause for the "valley of death" is due to lack of funding. This is further complicated by cultural differences and market scale. For instance, GPS tracking shoes developed in the United States are a highly successful gerontechnology product in that country. But due to Hong Kong's limited market size, the localisation cost is prohibitively high, which means the product is not made available locally.

Despite these challenges, there is a future for gerontechnology in the city. According to the 2015 Ageing Asia Silver Economy Index, Hong Kong ranked second in Asia Pacific in terms of spending power of the aging population and their children. In other words, there are huge market potentials for gerontechnology. Amid this background, we sought to raise awareness and stimulate discussions among different stakeholders. Aside from promoting innovation in Hong Kong, we also hope seniors would benefit from gerontechnology and live a better life.

#### 掌握銀髮市場新機遇

香港人口日漸老化,令人憂慮各界對高齡社會的意識 不足,資源與服務難以配合需求;結合老年學及創新 科技的樂齡科技,可帶來轉危為機的可能。

本報告是全港首個樂齡科技概況研究, 細看了72款 本地和海外的產品,將之劃分為:醫、食、住、行四大 範疇,並檢視這個生態系統的落差與限制。樂齡科技 不但惠及長者和其護理人員,更為創新科技界注入 研發新產品的動力, 最終推動總體經濟的生產力。 不過,香港的樂齡科技業界面對很多困難,阻礙着 相關發展。

舉個例子,衛生署的醫療券及社會福利署的長者社區 照顧服務券試驗計劃都不可用於購買樂齡科技產品, 如果能資助長者購買相關產品,將可為樂齡科技行業 注入更多資金。事實上,不少初創企業在相關產品推出 市場之前,常因資金不足而結業,俗稱為走不出「死亡 之谷 | 。而文化差異與市場規模等問題,亦困擾着市場 經營者,例如在美國開發的內置GPS衛星定位的追蹤 鞋在美國很成功,但由於香港市場太小,導致引入的 成本過高,產品於是不行其門而入。本報告全面地指出 香港樂齡產業現存的五大缺陷,並細數其中的問題。

不過,香港樂齡科技及護理科技的未來仍是樂觀的,2015年的 「Ageing Asia 銀髮商機指數」按老年人口及其子女的消費能力,本港於 亞太地區排名第二,預期樂齡科技的總開支及其市場規模於未來 會有大幅增長。本報告期望帶來社會的關注與討論,不同的持份者 能更好合作,在推動本港科研之餘,也讓優秀科技的種子在香港 茁壯成長,最終能讓長者更舒適地安享晚年。





#### Policy Recommendations

We are a think tank that emphasises both ideas and actions. Aside from conducting research, we also value engaging stakeholders through vigorous advocacy and promotional campaigns.

The Chief Executive, Mrs. Carrie Lam, highly praised our research reports on the occasion of the launch of our Ageing Society report last December. She noted that our recommendations were valuable references for public policy formulation. As such, it was encouraging to see a large number of measures in this year's Budget and Policy Address that aligned with our policy recommendations. In addition, we actively took part in public consultations initiated by the Government on policy areas such as land use planning and the building of "Smart City". We also submitted policy recommendations to the Legislative Council.



This seminar offered an overview of how China emerged from a devastated, war-torn country to a global power in the past century. Professor Jin pointed out that there were two distinctive periods in contemporary Chinese history. From 1840 to 1949, the preoccupation of all forward-thinking Chinese people was national survival, and from 1949 to 2050, national revival has become the main focus.

He noted that the first 100 years was particularly bumpy, whereas the latter 100 years was not smooth either. However, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) is able to renew itself and has taken up the responsibility in saving the country and ensuring its revival. As such, this explains why the CCP is able to maintain its political legitimacy in the Chinese political landscape.

金一南教授敘述近代中國經歷重重苦難,在建國前有如一盤散沙,至新中國成立,如何改變了這個命運,並進入「發展中國」的階段。近年中國的經濟與科技成就,舉世矚目,而民族復興的大任將落在我們及未來一代的身上。

金一南引用孫中山先生的名言,「歷史潮流浩浩蕩蕩,順之則昌,逆廢則亡」。指出人的生命和事業都很短暫,如能把個人事業融入到國家民族的歷史進程中,就會像一滴融入大海的水,永不乾枯。

金教授總結説,從1840年到1949年,所有先進的中國人,目標都是「救中國」這三個字。1949年新中國成立到2050年,則是另一個命題:發展中國。前100年歷經坎坷,後100年也走了很多彎路,但是中國共產黨不斷自我更新,在民族救亡和復興過程中擔起重任,顯示了共產黨存在於中國政壇的合理性和合法性。



The three internationally renowned experts offered their unique insights and analysis on the development of the Chinese political system. Professor Yu Keping explained that in China, the Chinese Communist Party would always take a leadership role in managing the country, but the way how the country is managed is subject to change.

Dr. Eric X. Li offered a critique of Western liberal democracy, arguing that different interest groups within the system have amassed enormous power and become formidable obstacles to reforms, which in turn causes political gridlock and systemic rigidity. On the other hand, he suggested that as a one-party state, the system has enabled China to experience phenomenal economic development for the past 60 years.

Professor Zhang Xudong noted that Hong Kong did not play a role in contemporary Chinese nation building, which produced a rift in building a national identity. He suggested that more work could be done in education, academia and public discourse so that a new identity could be forged in society.

三位 蜚聲國際的專家講述他們對中國政治體制發展的獨有看法和分析。俞可平教授的講題是《中國大陸如何治理》,指出使中國經濟騰飛的是政治上很好地把「變」與「不變」結合了起來,一步步走出自己的路。

他解釋,中國以黨為核心的領導體制是不變,變的是國家治理。如是者政府與地方、國家與社會的關係有所改變,從人治改變為法治,以統治改變為治理,中國有效地修補不足和過時的政府制度,從穩定和低風險的方向,走出自己的路。

李世默博士講題是《黨係乜東東》,西方式民主政黨的日子不太好過,關鍵原因是民主體制內的利益集團不斷積累權力,沒有一個團體有能力進行改革,但任何一個團體皆有能力去阻撓改革,如是者,造成了政治停滯、制度僵化。

中國是一黨制,但從1949年到現在,60幾年之間改變幅度之大,找不出一個現代國家如是,所以中國能夠穩步前進。然而,21世紀是一個在改革中競爭的時代,全世界包括中國都需要改革,改革失敗將成輸家。

張旭東教授主講題是《中國主權和國家認同》,重點在香港人對中國的認同。他說:「中國認同是一個複合體,包括國家的認同和文化的認同,合在一起才叫中國認同。」

香港在塑造近代中國國家的決定性歷史經驗上,沒有參與也沒有經驗,所以出現內部對中國認同上的撕裂,不過,張教授指出,我們可以從教育、學術、公共討論都多做工作,從而讓香港社會上下取得一個新的認同。

As far as the Chinese leadership is concerned, he opined that the "One Belt One Road" initiative is an example of the Chinese response to globalisation, as it focuses on building a global partnership network that transcends geographical and ideological boundaries.

何亞非闡釋中國在全球化的變動新形勢下,如何應對挑戰,擔當起領導重任。近年全球化為世界各地帶來了巨大經濟發展,包括中國內地和香港。無可否認的是,全球化之中既有贏家也有輸家;不但國與國之間如此,社會的貧富分化也日益加劇。

但問題不在於全球化本身,全球化幾乎令各方都受惠, 區別只在於受惠的程度或大或小,問題在於大多數國家 未能處理好全球化帶來的社會不公問題。

何亞非指出,中國領導人提出了一個全球化的概念,就是要建立一個全球合作夥伴網絡。其一是近年來推動的「一帶一路」政策,奉行一項創新的全球治理,它跨越地域之別、意識形態之別、不同的貨幣區域之別,旨在大力推進並引領全球化進程。

Yang Weimin explained that China was facing a new norm for economic growth, which consisted of four elements. First, the rate of economic growth has fallen from double digits to single digit. Second, the country's development has transformed from mass production into a model that emphasises quality and efficiency. Third, it no longer blindly strives to achieve numerical targets. Fourth, economic growth should be led by innovation and technology rather than a mass labour force.

Under the new norm, the focus in 2017 is to deepen structural reforms, including cutting excessive industrial capacity, destocking, deleveraging, lowering costs and improving weak links. Additionally, there are measures to further supply-side structural reform in agriculture, revitalise the real economy and facilitate the healthy development of the real estate market. In short, these measures aimed to correct the long-term mismatch of resources between supply and demand.

The trend of the Chinese economy remained positive, despite an overall policy framework that called for stability and risk avoidance so to prevent a systemic financial crisis.

楊偉民表示,國家正面對全新的經濟趨勢,即所謂的「新常態」,這裡共有四個特徵:經濟增長由以往的雙位數字,轉為最低5%至6%;發展模式由粗放式,轉為追求查證質量與效益;不再只提數量達標,而是講求優質調整;最後就是從勞動力改為以創新、科技帶動增長。

在新常態之下,國家2017年重點是「深化供給側結構性改革」,具體任務:一是深入推進「三去一降一補」(去產能、去庫存、去槓桿、降成本、補短板);二是深入推進農業供給側結構性改革;三是着力振興實體經濟;四是促進房地產市場平穩健康發展。四項工作為修正國家的供給體系和結構,糾正長期市場與需求的資源錯配現狀。

對於國家經濟的走勢,目前可用八個字概括:「緩中趨穩,穩中向好」,2016年中國GDP平均增長仍達6.7%,不過,在穩定的前提下,確保不發生系統性金融風險。

In this two-hour sold-out presentation and discussion, Mo Yan pointed out that Hong Kong's unique language, history, geography and cultural environment have helped nurture many top literary works. He believed that Hong Kong should play a key role in enriching contemporary Chinese literature.

Asides from offering his thoughts on the relationship between Hong Kong and Mainland China in a literary context, Mo also suggested that writing should not be based solely on inspiration. While he admitted that many of his dreams got him inspired to write, his life experience actually provided the context for his novels.

In terms of technology, Mo was unfazed by the rise of digital literature. As an optimist, he believed that literary would not disappear in the age of rapid technological development.

莫言在長達兩小時的演講及交流中,從香港的文學開始, 一路引領出他的文學觀、個人寫作經歷以及小説技巧、全程 一氣呵成, 絕無冷場。

莫言指出,香港有獨特的語言、歷史、地理及文化環境,造就 了很多獨一無二的優秀文學作品,例如劉以鬯的《對倒》, 《酒徒》是經典,西西的《我城》和《像我這樣的一個女子》 也是非常傑出,他認為香港在中國當代文學應佔有一個很 重要的位置。

莫言表示,文學是基於生活,而非單靠一度閃光的靈感,雖然 他承認自己多部小説都是從朦朧的夢境中得到啟發,可是 沒有童年和故鄉的經歷,以及生活的累積,小説便寫不出來。

在座談會的環節上,莫言表示,自從得到諾貝爾文學獎 之後,因為有很多他認為值得的場面要赴會,加上下筆寫作 更加謹慎, 所以5年來未有新作。

作為中國知名作家,莫言來港成為香港與內地焦點新聞。 他在演講中提到網絡文學興起的現象時說:「我從來就是 一個文學的『樂觀主義者』,我不認為文學會在現代科技 快速發展的時代裡消失掉。」這個觀點尤其受到傳媒重視。

Professor Jin suggested that among the four great ancient civilisations, only the Chinese civilisation could continue to survive in these days. While modern China had experienced three war defeats and a near obliteration of the nation, the Chinese civilisation, with the concerted efforts of the great patriots, managed to revive. Patriotism, in his view, is about maintaining a space for national survival and the continuation of its civilisation.

According to Professor Jin, China's understanding of national interest is remarkably different from the West, and from the Chinese perspective, there are six core national interests, namely sovereignty, national security, territorial integrity, unification, the nation's political system, and protection for social stability and sustainable economic and social development. As such, China would defend these core national interests at all costs.

金一南教授分析,在四大文明古國之中,只有中華文明能夠延續至今,不過,近代中國也曾經歷過三次戰敗,國家幾近滅亡,中華文明最終死灰復燃、鳳凰涅槃,這要歸功於偉大的愛國者。愛國就是整個民族生存空間的維護和文明的延續,至於國家安全方面,維護國家安全需要力量,亦即是要有完整的國力,其中硬實力與軟實力必須同時兼備。

中國與西方對國家利益的理解,有截然不同之處,了解這一點非常重要。中國有六個國家核心利益:國家主權、國家安全、領土完整、國家統一、國家政治制度和社會大局的穩定、經濟社會可持續發展的基本保障。這六個核心國家利益,是中國不惜以戰爭手段捍衛的底線。

他表示:「我們一定要記住小平同志講的一句話,以自己的國家利益 為最高準則來談問題和處理問題,一直是我們今天要牢牢記住的。 我們長期熱衷於關係的維護,我們以後一定要學會維護利益。」

金教授總結說:「歷史現實交錯重疊,使我們對國家安全和民族 尊嚴有更深刻的理解,對維護國家安全有更強烈的期望,我們一定 要有效地維護我們的安全。|

#### Joining hands with Hong Kong community to foster innotech development

The InnoTech Expo 2016 was held between 24 September and 1 October 2016. Themed "Innovation Drives Growth, Technology Shapes Future", the Expo attracted over 60.000 visitors and had successfully planted the seeds of innovation and technology in the city.

Mr. C.H. Tung, Chairman of OHKF, said at the Opening Ceremony that the InnoTech Expo 2016 meant a lot to Hong Kong people, as the local community could explore the nation's innovation and technological advancement at a very close range. He had also remarked that the Expo was a platform designed for young people, as innovation and technology could help their future development.

The 100,000 square feet exhibition hall at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre was divided into 8 specialised zones where on display are real objects and models that showcased 60 projects or items of China's cutting-edge technologies.

The Expo had also designated an extra zone that showcased outstanding scientists in Hong Kong and internationally-awarded local R&D projects. 36 specialists' forums and popular science seminars were held to educate the general public on the cause of scientific and technological innovation.

The overwhelming support that we received from the Ministry of Science & Technology and four key departments in the Mainland, as well as the HKSAR Government was truly encouraging, which made the Expo an innovation gala for the broader society.

The Academy of Sciences of Hong Kong joined hands with the Hong Kong Academy of Engineering Sciences and the Hong Kong Institution of Science to organise the "Innovation & Technology of Hong Kong Marching On" forum, featuring 10 local top-notch scientists and engineers to share their insights on Hong Kong's contributions to global technological research.

基金會主席董建華先生在開幕禮致辭時表示,「創科博覽2016」對 香港人意義重大,因為它為香港人提供了一個親身觸摸及認識已 走到國際前列的國家科技實力的視窗和機會。董先生也指出, 「創科博覽2016」也是為年青人而設,因為科創能夠大大幫助他們的 未來發展,是一個尋找理想生活的良好機會和平台。

博覽場館逾10萬平方呎,劃分8個展區,共展出60項國家尖端而領先 國際的科技成就,包括34件實物項目(如探月返回艙、深潛潛水 裝具、手術機械人等),以及24件模型。

博覽除了主力展示國家科技成就之外,還特關香港區,展示香港 科研專家過去及現時的重點研究工作及成就;以及實行科普到位, 舉辦36場「專家論壇」及「科普講堂」,讓市民及學生分享教授和 專家的心得。

「創科博覽2016」最令人鼓舞的其中一個環節,是獲得多 方面廣泛的支持和響應。首先是得到國家科技部及其他 四個部委的大力支持,聯繫7位國寶級國際頂尖科學家 主持多場「專家論壇」。其次是得到香港社會各界及 特區政府等的積極響應,使博覽演變成為全社會為 創新齊步向前的盛會。

To promote innovation and entrepreneurship of Hong Kong, we co-organised the Mainland Expedition on Entrepreneurship and Technology (MEET) with the Torch High Technology Industry Development Center, Ministry of Science and Technology (Torch Center). The trips took place between 23 and 29 October 2016 and saw 100 Hong Kong young entrepreneurs, divided into four separate groups, visiting high-tech hubs in Hangzhou, Xi'an, Jinan and Wuhan before rendezvousing in Beijing. On the fifth day of the expedition, they visited numerous high-tech companies in the capital and participated in a forum with the honourable presence of Vice Minister of Science and Technology Dr. Li Meng.

#### 協助香港青年企業家把握雙創機遇

杭州是很多成功電子商貿和金融科技企業的發源地,團員走訪了中國電商巨頭阿里巴巴、互聯網巨頭網易,以及全國線上支付排名第三的連連集團。

濟南高新區正在推進智能化生產技術,學員走訪了中國最大的伺服器製造商 浪潮集團(Inspur),以及開發電力行業特種機械人技術的魯能智能有限 公司,同時又考察有「文化+金融」特色的區域性金融商務中心 — 漢峪金谷。



# Stimulating the innovative minds of Hong Kong's post-secondary students

Riding on the success of the MEET initiative, we co-organised the Mainland Expedition on Entrepreneurship & Technology for University Students (MEET4U) between 5 and 11 June 2017. The trips saw 100 post-secondary students, divided into three separate groups, visiting high-tech hubs in Tianjin, Zhengzhou and Taiyuan before rendezvousing in Xi'an. Different from other university visits, MEET4U focuses on innovation and entrepreneurship and covers multiple cities at the same time. Participants are also able to seize the opportunity to experience the Chinese cultural and historical uniqueness.

#### 啟廸香港大專生的雙創思維

團結香港基金與國家科學及技術部火炬高技術產業開發中心於2017年6月5日至11日首次合辦「香港大專生雙創內地行」(Mainland Expedition on Entrepreneurship & Technology for University Students - MEET4U),這是延續去年舉辦「香港創業青年內地行」(MEET)的成功基礎上,把活動擴至學生層面,深化推動香港創新創業。

活動安排100多名香港院校學生,先分三組到訪天津、鄭州、太原三大高新城市。天津行程主題為「生物醫藥、儲能技術」,

而鄭州的重型機械技術先進,學員參觀了鄭州機械研究所以及國家重點實驗室。太原團主題為「文化創意、煤化工」, 學員參觀煤化工企業賽鼎工程有限公司、自動化技術為主的 山西科達自控股份有限公司。

學員最後在西安匯合,西安正打造成為「一帶一路」重鎮,當地栽培青年創業家不遺餘力。學員主要參觀電子信息、生物醫藥項目,並與西安之創業人士、在當地的香港企業家和投資者作多場交流,深入了解當地雙創環境。

與一般大學訪問團不同,「香港大專生雙創內地行」學員來自多間院校,以創新創業為主題,規模觸及幾個城市同步進行,不單見識內地科技與創新發展,感受各處「大眾創業,萬眾創新」的熱烈氣氛,更體驗不同城市蘊含之中華歷史文化特色。

#### Promoting social innovation and creating shared value

Business for Social Good (BSG) is a platform aims to foster social innovation to solve the problems the local community is currently facing, with the support of local business leaders.

#### BSG's Inaugural Initiative - "Bees & Trees Alliance" Business leaders joined hands with social enterprises to foster social innovation

Inspired by the "bees and trees theory" put forward by Dr. Geoff Mulgan, a UK expert in social innovation, the Alliance aims to pair up business leaders ("trees") and social innovators ("bees") to foster social innovation through combined creativity and resources.

OHKF had received applications from 80 start-up enterprises, 6 teams were shortlisted. Their service scopes included organising kids to cheer up lonely old people, caring for old people with the aid of mobile apps, providing information for retirees to help them continue contributing to the community, recruiting university graduates as teachers at grassroot schools, training marginalised youngsters to be boxing coaches, and reusing discarded old wood materials. These 6 teams were then paired up with business leaders to enhance their potential for growth. At the finale taken place at the launch ceremony of BSG, each paired team made a presentation and BSG members casted their votes to select the winners of the Gold, Silver, and Bronze Awards.



It is a one-year pogramme that recruits outstanding university students to teach at schools with a significant number of grassroots students.

#### 序幕活動《蜂樹盟》計劃 匯聚商界及社企精英 創造社會創新環境

《蜂樹盟》計劃(Bees & Trees Alliance),是 「商社聚腎」的序幕活動。

計劃借鑒「密蜂與大樹」理論,目的在拉動商界 領袖(大樹)和社會創新者(蜜蜂)結盟,聯手 以創新方式及更多資源解決社會問題。

「蜜蜂與大樹」理論由英國社會創新學家 Dr. Geoff Mulgan 提出,將社會創新人士形容 為蜜蜂,象徵活潑機靈、充滿創意及具傳播 能力;而具規模的大機構,則像大樹般具有 紮 實 的 根 基 和 充 沛 省 源 。 大 樹 可 補 足 密 蜂 所缺的資金、人 脈 和 專業 知 識,雙方合作 即能發揮協同效應,產生深遠效果。

《蜂樹盟》計劃共收到80家初創企業申請,經過 兩輪評選選出6組優勝隊伍。優勝隊伍的服務 範圍包括動員小朋友為老人家舒解困憂、利用 手機程式貼身關懷長者、協助退休人士繼續貢獻 社會、招募大學畢業生到基層學校任教、利用 拳擊訓練讓邊青與社會主流回復接軌,以及使 舊木重生的回收木材工作。6個組別分別被 安排與商界精英結成「商社夥伴」,從而提升 發展潛能。6組「商社夥伴」於總決賽中介紹 其社創項目,由「商社聚賢」成員投票選出金、 銀、銅獎得主。
